TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Prizes are awarded on total boat stringer weight
- 2. Largemouth, Smallmouth, and Kentucky Spotted Base (15 inch minimum)
- 3. All fish must be caught5 on rod and reel, using artificial bait. Only 1 rig may be used at a time.
- 4. No trolling.
- 5. Two persons per boat only.
- 6. One (1) recently deceased fish (dead fish with pink gills) will be weighed, but will receive a 2 pound penalty.
 - a. If two dead fish are presented, the team will be disqualified.
 - b. If the biggest bass of the tournament is weighed in and is dead, the 2 pounds will be deducted from that fish, dropping big bass weight by 2 pounds, which could possibly knock that fish out of contention for big bass.
- 7. Any short fish presented for weigh-in will cause 2 pounds to be deducted per short fish from total weight and loss of fish, meaning short fish will not be weighed.
 - a. Short fish by measurement with mouth closed and tail pinched together. There are no disputes. All fish are measured on a Bass Pro "Golden Rule". There will be a courtesy board.
 - b. Dead fish, those with white gills, iced, frozen or mutilated fish.

IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS REGARDING THE ABOVE, ASK THE OPINION OF ANOTHER FISHERMAN – DON'T ASK FOR A RULING AT THE WEIGH-IN

- 8. All fish must be brought to the scales in a plastic bag with water or they will not be weighed. All fish must be released (except trophy)
- 9. No trailering of boats to other areas.
- 10. No fishing within 50 yards of another contestant unless there is a mutual agreement
- 11. Missouri Department of Conservation rules will apply. THERE IS A 6 FISH LIMIT PER BOAT.
- 12. Live wells will be checked.
- 13. Everyone must check in at **6:00 A.M.** on the main dock. Tournament hours are **6:30 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.** (weather permitting). Weigh in will start at **3:30 P.M.**

Note: ***1 LB. penalty for the first 5 minutes of late weigh in.

***3 LB penalty for more than 5 minutes, but less than 10 minutes late weigh-in.

***10 minutes or later – disqualified.
