IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT RULES

ELIGIBILITY:

Only Elks in good standing in a Lodge in the State of Missouri are eligible to participate and must have a current card, spouses of Elks are also eligible to participate, Non-Elks are eligible to bowl only 1 year and on a limited basis. No more than 2 non- Elks per team and they must bowl with an Elk in Doubles. Participants may enter more than once in doubles and teams if they have different partners. Participants are permitted to enter only once in singles.

HANDICAP:

This tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis. Each bowler shall receive a handicap of 80% of the difference between his average and 220 pins in each event entered.

Each bowler shall use highest average attained in any "sanctioned" League averages as of the end of the 2020-2021 season, including summer leagues. A minimum of twenty one (21) games must have been bowled to establish an average. A new bowler or a bowler without a 2020-2021 average may use the highest average of the current season based on twenty-one (21) games or more by the tournament date. League verification of average must be presented at time of tournament. ALL OTHERS WILL BOWL SCRATCH.

AT THE TIME OF BOWLING, a bowler having twenty-one (21) or more games this season, and whose average is ten (10) pins greater than the final average of last season, must use the current average for entry in this tournament. A bowler whose average is (10) pins lower than the final average of last season due to injury or illness may ask the tournament director for a re-rating.

Failure to use the proper average or make corrections prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average.

It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his team captain or others. All averages will be verified by USBC records.

A bowler who has qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the past twelve (12) month period must report his actual score, position and amount won to the tournament management at the time of entry for possible re-rating. Such re-rating will be accomplished before the entrant bowls, and if not accepted, the entry fee will be refunded. USBC RULE 319A-D AND 319E WILL APPLY IN THE PROCEDURE OF RE-RATING. PARTICIPANTS MUST ACQUAINT THEMSELVES WITH THIS RULE.

PRIZES:

One hundred (100) percent of all prize money shall be paid back in the event entered on a handicap basis. Champions shall be declared in each of the events based on actual pin fall plus handicap, and each winner shall receive a plaque. In addition to all-events award, the Missouri Elks Bowling Association will award plaques of the highest individual scratch game and highest individual scratch series of the tournament.

Distribution of the prize money shall be left to the Secretary of the Association. The amount and number of prizes shall be dependent on the total number of entries in each event. At least one prize for every six (6) entries will be awarded. In the all-events division, at least one (1) for each twenty (20) entries will receive prize money.

SUBSTITUTIONS AND LINE-UP CHANGES:

A substitute in the singles must also substitute for the same bowler in doubles, and a substitute in the doubles must also substitute for the same bowler in singles. Three substitutes are allowed on a team. ALL SUBSTITUTES OR CHANGES MUST BE MADE NO LATER THAN ONE (1) HOUR BEFORE SCHEDULED TIME OF BOWLING.

GENERAL:

All USBC rules and regulations governing tournaments will be strictly enforced. All squads will start promptly at the time set forth in the schedule. A copy of the schedule will be mailed to each team captain. NO REFUNDS AFTER 1 WEEK PRIOR TO START OF TOURNAMENT.
