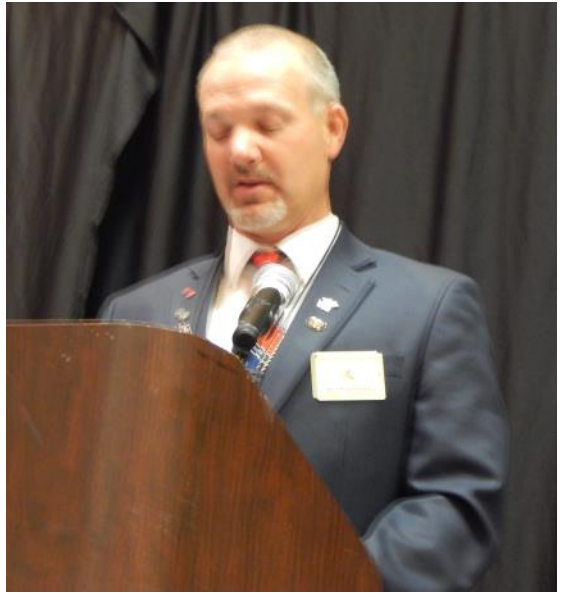

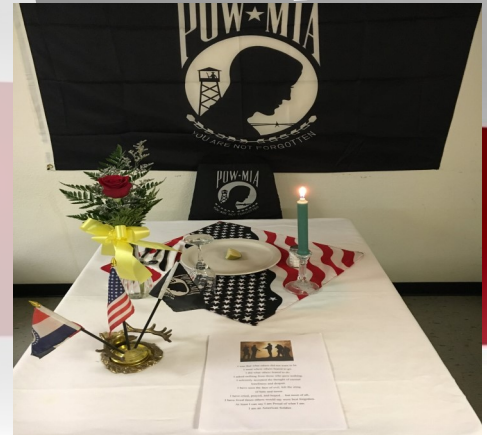




# Annual Veterans Dinner

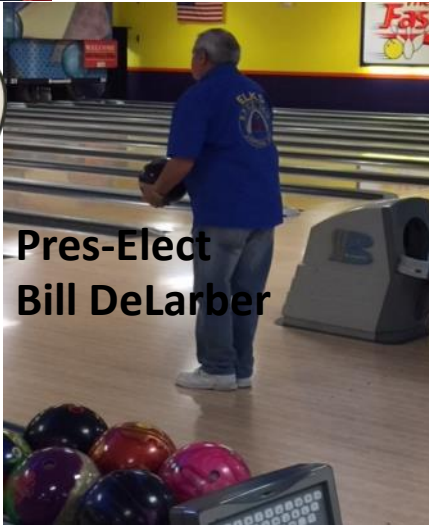
